Bridging the Gap for Safer Travel to the South Coast!

Divall's Earthmoving & Bulk Haulage, in conjunction with 'Bridgeworks', recently completed the works associated with the upgrade of the Nadgigomar Bridge, on Windellama Road.

The works were funded in their entirety by Federal and State grants, falling under the 'Fixing Country Roads' and 'Bridges Renewal' programs. Divall's undertook extensive earthworks to realign the approach to the new bridge, which was constructed by Bridgeworks.

The new dual lane bridge has replaced the original single lane, and has been installed at an elevated level, thus alleviating flooding issues which previously occurred, consequently hindering access for locals. From start to finish, the works took approximately 3 months, and required a large amount of certifiable and tested earthworks to ensure safety standards were met.

The Bridge was officially opened on the 24th August, 2018, by Pru Goward and Bob Kirk, who are pictured with Dave Matthews, Divall's Project Manager, Pedro Vendemiatti, Divall's Project Engineer, & representative from Bridgeworks.
