

COMPLETION OF THE GUNNING WATER SUPPLY UPGRADE – CONSTRUCTION OF A 100ML IN-GROUND STORAGE RESERVOIR

On the 14th of March, 2014, Divall's Earthmoving & Bulk Haulage completed a 100ML In-Ground Storage Reservoir for the Upper Lachlan Shire Council.

The scope of work under this contract consisted of the supply of all materials, plant and equipment for the construction of the storage facility and other associated works including pipe work. Due to the location of the job site, Divall's was able to recycle 5,317 Tonne of Rock on site and re-use it on the project, as well as sourcing sand from local suppliers at Dalton Sand Pit.



Throughout the project, various challenges presented themselves which included compaction of materials, oversized rock, dry conditions and limited water at times.

Dave Matthews, Project Manager for Divall's, would like to recognise the efforts and hard work of all those involved in this project. The dedication, knowledge and ability to carry out tasks in a timely manner has meant that work was completed 6 weeks ahead of the scheduled program.
