

MINI FUEL TANKER

In November 2012, Divall's Earthmoving & Bulk Haulage took delivery of a brand new Mitsubishi Fuso light truck, fitted with ATE tankers containing fuel and oils.

This is a great innovation for the Divall's team, and it will be ultra-effective by way of;

- Saving machine operators time which is spent refuelling machines after hours
- Preventing unnecessary travelling to fuel depots
- Efficient bulk deliveries by way of a 5,000L tank
- A 3000 litre oil tank plus grease

When machines are working in remote areas, or a number of machines may be on the same construction site for a long period of time, it is cost-effective and environmentally beneficial to re-fuel on site, thus restricting travel time for operators.

Operator, Dave Polzin, joined the Divall's team last year and has settled in with the Divall's team very quickly. Dave makes himself available to re-fuel machines daily, as and when required.
