DIVALL'S WIN EARTH AWARD FOR SECOND CONSECUTIVE YEAR

This award was presented by the Civil Contractors Federation (CCF) at the annual Earth Awards held in Sydney on the 29th of June, and is recognised at a state level.

The **CCF Earth Awards** have the specific aim of recognising outstanding work in construction and environmental excellence which reflects development and use of the best technologies by Australian civil contractors.

In their 19th year, the Earth Awards are the most prestigious awards in civil infrastructure including; roads, bridges, railways, marine structures and utilities that are the economic veins and arteries that link the Australian community.

The Award was earned by completing a project that comprised of road widening roadworks, upgrading the last unsealed sections of MR 54 north of the Abercrombie River, on the Goulburn/Bathurst Road, Tuena.

The project work area is located on land which encompasses 23 identified National Parks and Wildlife fauna, such as reptiles, 3 species are known as "threatened" within this conversation zone.

The works were completed for, and in conjunction with, Bathurst Regional Council and Roads and Maritime Services.
