WARNING – BITUMEN BANDITS BACK IN TOWN !!!

In August 2015, NSW Fair Trading issued a warning to all consumers and businesses to be wary of anyone offering cheap bitumen work. Over the recent weeks, the 'Bitumen Bandits' have again started working within the Goulburn Area. Typically, these crews come from interstate and approach local residents offering cheap bitumen that they have 'left over' from a job they have completed on a main road. The product they are offering that is labelled as 'Bitumen' is often a water based emulsion that is sprayed on often an unprepared surface. At the time of work, the surface will appear to have a neat and professional finish, however, within twelve months the surface often cracks and breaks up. The Bitumen Bandits will often ask to be paid in cash and will typically leave town within weeks of completing the job with no warranty or guarantee on the surface.

To carry out private bitumen works, Contractors must have a Bitumen License before doing any work. Consumers should ask to sight a license with details of the trader's name and license category. If approached by the Bitumen Bandits, members of the public are encouraged to contact NSW Department of Fair Trading.
