PNEUMATIC TANKER

Divall's Earthmoving & Bulk Haulage are the proud owners of their first pneumatic tanker.

A **pneumatic tanker** is a large body tank trailer that empties via a pump and forced air. It is primarily used for products like cement, flour, lime or fly ash.

The tanker will be used to cart cement products to Divall's sister company, Concrete4Goulburn, and to our new venture stabilising road with lime & cement.

The tanker was manufactured by Jamieson Tankers in Adelaide, and is made of steel with the capacity of 42 cubic metres.

Benefits to Divall's and Concrete4Goulburn include;

- In control of cement supply
- Value adding
- Flexibility of haulage fleet

This tanker operates as part of the Roads & Maritime Service's Higher Mass Limits (HML) scheme which allows a 29tonne payload.

In between carting lime for our stabiliser, Divall's anticipate carting approximately 7 loads of cement to Concrete4Goulburn per week ex Berrima, and 2 loads of fly ash per fortnight from Mount Piper, near Lithgow.
