

WOLLONDILLY WALKING TRACK !

In late 2015, Goulburn Mulwaree Council put out a Tender seeking the services of a suitably qualified and experienced Company for construction of the Wollondilly Walking Track. After submitting a Tender to comply with the specific requirements, Divall's Earthmoving & Bulk Haulage are excited to announce that they were successful in obtaining this contract with their Tender Submission.
