GUNNING WATER SUPPLY UPGRADE – CONSTRUCTION OF A 100ML IN-GROUND STORAGE RESERVOIR

On the 7th of May, 2013, the Upper Lachlan Shire Council in conjunction with NSW Public Works issued an open Tender for the Construction of a 100ML In-Ground Storage Reservoir at Gunning NSW.

The scope of work under this contract consisted of the supply of all materials, plant and equipment for the construction of the storage facility and other associated works including pipe work.

The Tendering process requires, not only the submission of a price to carry out the work required, but also supporting documentation to show the capability of the Company wishing to carry out the work. This can include things such as a proposed Construction Methodology, Schedule of Experience and Referees, Proposed Personnel to carry out the work, Work Health & Safety Information, Quality Management System Compliance and availability of both machinery and personnel.

After two months of compiling documentation in order to submit the Tender and comply with NSW Public Works, Divall's Earthmoving and Bulk Haulage was awarded the Contract. This is a beneficial and positive venture not only for Divall's, but also the broader community.

Being contracted by the Upper Lachlan Shire Council has meant that Divall's Earthmoving have been able to keep jobs 'closer to home'. Due to the large scale of the work, we have been able to employ some of the local residents of Gunning and surrounds to help complete the job.

Divall's have also secured large works within the Braidwood and Taralga districts which also gives locals within those areas, the opportunity to secure long, and short-term employment.
